

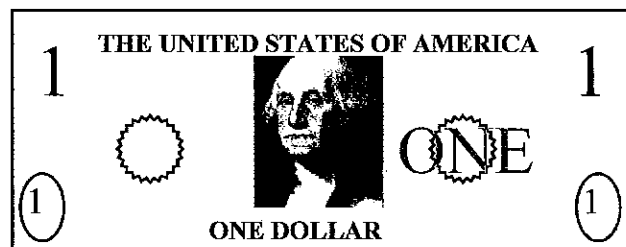
# Trading Up

## Materials:

- 1 bag of money for each player
  - 5 pennies
  - 2 nickels
  - 2 dimes
  - 4 quarters
  - One dollar bill
- 2 dice
- Trading Up gameboard

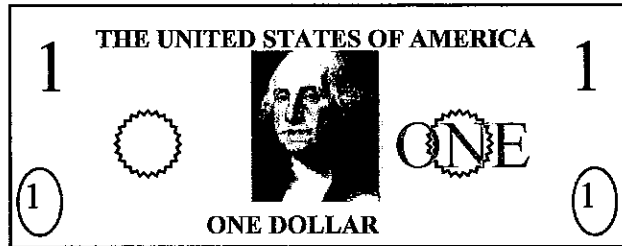
## Directions:

- Players toss two dice each. Player with highest sum goes first.
- Player A tosses both dice and finds the sum. Player A takes that many cents from his/her money bag and arranges it on the gameboard using the fewest coins possible.
- Player B tosses both dice and finds the sum. Player B takes that many cents from his/her money bag and arranges it on the gameboard using the fewest coins possible.
- Player A tosses both dice and finds the sum. Player A takes that many cents from his/her money bag and arranges it on the gameboard, trading up to larger value coins as much as possible. NOTE: Player A may not have more coins in a row than there are outlines in that row.
- Player B plays the same as Player A above.
- The first player to trade up to a dollar bill wins the game. NOTE: The winning player may go over one dollar.

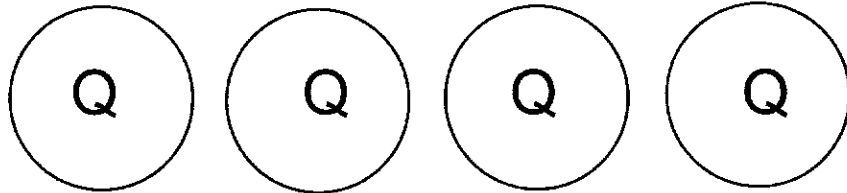

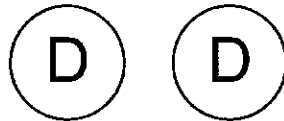

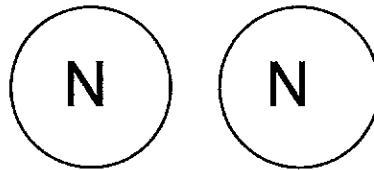
Quarters



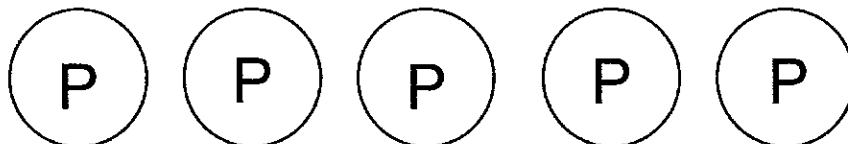

# Clean Up the Money!



**Players:** 2

**Materials:** Game mat  
1 regular die  
1 die marked A, B, C, D, E, F  
6 each of pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters

**Directions:**

1. Each player takes 3 of each coin.
2. Players take turns placing one coin at a time on any empty spot until all 24 coins have been placed.
3. Player A rolls both dice.
4. Player A forms the ordered pair that shows (e.g. (A, 4)). If there is a coin on the space, he/she takes it and throws again. If there is no coin on the space, it is Player B's turn.
5. Player B rolls both dice.
6. Player B forms the ordered pair that shows (e.g. (C, 1)). If there is a coin on the space, he/she takes it and throws again. If there is no coin on the space, it is Player A's turn.
7. Play alternates back and forth until one player takes his/her sixth coin from the mat.
8. Both players then count their money.
9. The player with the most money wins.

**Variations:**

- **\$1.00 wins:** Play until one player has removed coins that total \$1.00. This player wins the game.
- **10 coins win:** Play until one player has removed 10 coins. Players count money. Player with highest total wins.
- **Big Money:** Add 6 half-dollars and 6 dollars to the original coins.

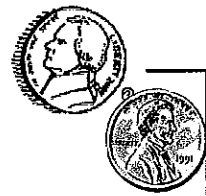

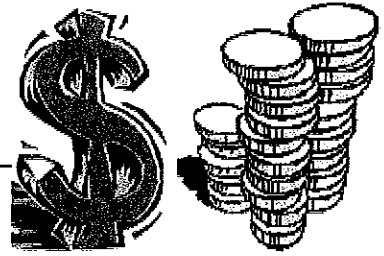
