
Dual enrollment is an effort by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to encourage a broader range of students to experience postsecondary coursework and its increased academic rigor, while still in the supportive environment of their local high school. It is a locally administered program that allows a secondary student to receive both secondary and postsecondary credit for that coursework. Dual enrollment is for the capable, not just the exceptional, student. Students who demonstrate the necessary skills to succeed in a non-remedial college course are the targeted population for Pennsylvania's Dual Enrollment Grant Program. A successful dual enrollment program increases the rigor of the high school experience and a broader range of students think of themselves as "college material." Dual enrollment helps introduce more students to the advantages of postsecondary education and helps students transition into the culture and expectations of postsecondary institutions.

The Dual Enrollment Grant Program enables districts to receive funds to offset the cost of postsecondary coursework completed under an approved dual enrollment program. Dual enrollment grants will cover tuition, books, fees, and transportation.

Students in the Lebanon School District who are home-schooled or attend charter or private schools are able to participate in this program through the Lebanon School District. If you would like to be considered for this program in the 2010-2011 school year, please contact me at Lebanon High School. A letter indicating your interest would be appreciated. You will be asked to provide curriculum information and/or report cards. All students in the Lebanon School District must follow the same guidelines to be admitted into the Dual Enrollment Program. The deadline for your letter of interest is February 12, 2010.

RE: Dual Enrollment Program

This memorandum is to inform you of the opportunity for students to qualify to earn college credits through Harrisburg Area Community College, Lebanon Campus, as a high school student.

This opportunity permits students in grades 11 and 12, who qualify, to take an AP course in English Literature, AP Environmental Science, and AP Calculus. Parents of the students who qualify are required to pay a \$35 application fee and \$90 tuition to HACC. Key requirements for students to participate in the Dual Enrollment courses are as follows:

1. All students are required to fulfill prerequisite requirements for these courses.
2. Students are required to pass an entrance examination before they can be enrolled in a math or English class.
3. The student meets the qualifications set forth in the current enrollment agreement between the Eastern Lebanon County School District and HACC.
4. The charter school, non-public, private, or home education agrees to award second-degree credit for the dual enrollment process.
5. The student notifies the school district of residence of the intent to enroll in the dual enrollment program prior to the entrance of dual enrollment funding.
6. All criteria, policies and procedures of the Eastern Lebanon County School District are in effect.

SUBJECT: DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

This memorandum is to inform you of the opportunity for students who qualify to earn college credit through Harrisburg Area Community College, Lebanon Campus, as a high school student. The information below may be subject to change based on decisions made at Harrisburg Area Community College – Lebanon Campus.

This opportunity permits students in grades 11 and 12 who qualify to take a semester course in English Composition and a full year calculus or statistics course at Cedar Crest High School. Parents of the students who qualify are required to pay a \$35 application fee. The tuition fee will be as follows:

- AP Calculus AB 4 credits \$120
- AP Statistics 3 credits \$ 90
- English Composition 3 credits \$ 90

Once the student completes the course, the parent will be reimbursed the fee and tuition. Key requirements for students to participate in the Dual Enrollment courses are as follows:

1. All students are required to fulfill prerequisite requirements for these courses.
2. Students are required to pass an entrance examination before they can be enrolled.
3. The student meets the qualifications set forth in the current enrollment agreement between the Cornwall-Lebanon School District and HACC.
4. The charter school, non-public, private or home education agrees to award second degree credit for the dual enrollment process.
5. The student notifies the school district of residence of the intent to enroll in the dual enrollment program prior to the entrance of dual enrollment funding.
6. All criteria, policies and procedures of the Cornwall-Lebanon School District are in effect.
